RESEARCHING MADE SIMPLE!

College-level researching can be tough especially when you don't know where to start. Research consultations will help you move in the right direction. Research consultations are one-on-one appointments with a librarian. The librarian will work with you to find the sources and materials you need for your paper or project. READING/WRITING CENTER NOW HAS BRANCH IN STROZIER LIBRARY

Writing in college can be a hard job at times, no matter what how creative a person is. Don't be stressed! The FSU English Department's **Reading/Writing Center (RWC)** now has a branch in Strozier Library.

The RWC offers individualized tutoring to help with a variety of reading and writing needs.

Tutors will assist you in brainstorming topics for research papers and projects. Once the topic has been settled on, they will help you learn techniques for drafting, revising and adding finishing touches to your writing.

Additionally, the RWC offers assistance with personal essay writing for first-year students and CLAST Exam essay preparation. The tutors with the RWC can even help students shape up their professional letter-writing skills for graduate school and job applications.
