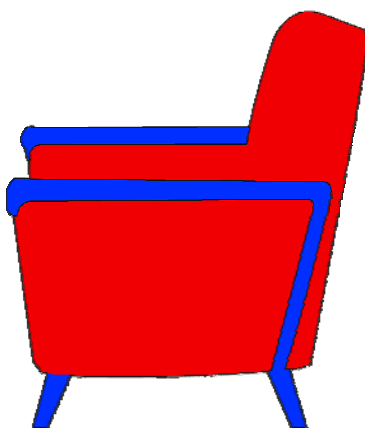
CHAIR-CISION08

- Do you have a group or research presentation and you need to have a large poster printed? The Strozier Library Digital Library Center has you covered! Students can have a large-format poster printed (maximum size 44" x 60", 1 print per semester). Other sizes with their printing maximums per semester include 20 x 30 (four); 11 x 17 (14); and 8 x 10 (33). The typical turn-around time from drop-off of digitization requests to pick up is 1 to 3 days. The DLC has other services including black & white/grayscale scanning, digital photographic imaging, as well as slide and film scanning.
