Universal Accessibility Study Rooms

In order to create a more inclusive environment for patrons of all levels of ability, FSU Libraries has created the Universal Accessibility Rooms. These wheelchair-accessible rooms contain an adjustable-height desk; a large-print, high-contrast keyboard; and two vertical, ergonomic mice. Below are directions, but if you need assistance locating the room, please don't hesitate to ask at the Scholar Support Desk.

Directions

- 1. Enter Strozier Library through the main entrance.
- 2. Use your FSUID to enter the security gates. For assistance, please talk to a member of the security staff.
- 3. Go directly forward to the Scholar Support Desk.
- 4. As for the Universal Accessibility Study Rooms.
- 5. Swipe your FSUID and a Scholar Support Desk staff member will provide you with the room key. Your reservation will last 4 hours, but if the room is still available, you may renew it.
- 6. Turn around and go toward the security gates (don't exit!).
- 7. Turn left toward the Starbucks. The elevator will be on your right.
- 8. Go to the second floor.
- 9. Exit the elevator and turn to your right (toward the main floor).
- 10. Take the left path into the open, quiet area.
- 11. Turn right toward the back of the building.
- 12. Pass through the double doors and turn left immediately. Room 2062 is the first room, and Room 2061 is the second room.
